Fredric A. Navarre is an educator, marketing executive, entrepreneur, and philanthropist who combines his education, business, and marketing expertise as the Founder and CEO of Park Place Valet and NGistix Global Freight. He is also an Academic Visitor at Rice University, George R. Brown School of Engineering, and a Technical Reviewer for NASA STEM Pathway Activities Consortium for Education. He has taught on the middle school, high school and college levels and was an elementary school administrator. He is a former lecturer in energy and corporate finance and served as Director of Academic Advising and Academic Integrity Remediation at Texas A&M University at Galveston. He has also been a review panelist for the National Science Foundation and has presented at the International Conference of Adults Learning Mathematics and the National Academic Advising Association.

Fredric is currently in his seventh year as Board Chairman of Achievement Through Leadership Foundation (ATLF). He is also the youngest board member for the American Cancer Society of Greater Houston, board member for Texas Southern University Jesse H. Jones School of Business Advisory Council, and is the 13th Polemarch of the Missouri City-Sugar Land (TX) Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. – known as the Mo-City Nupes. He is particularly proud of the accomplishments of Achievement Through Leadership Foundation, the nonprofit educational affiliate of the Mo-City Nupes. ATLF is known for hosting its annual Kasino Royale – the organization’s signature fundraiser. The growing charitable effort has allowed ATLF to quadruple the number and amount of scholarships to deserving students.

Fredric also presided over the creation and implementation of ATLF’s summer enrichment program called PROJECT S.L.A.M. – STEM and Leadership Academy for Males. The annual outreach engages Black and Hispanic young men in Greater Houston and encourages them to pursue careers in STEM. He was elected to the DREF Board of Directors in 2021. Fredric holds a bachelor’s degree in business from Southern University, an MBA in Energy Finance from Texas Southern University and a master’s degree in education from The University of Texas at Arlington. He is currently pursuing a doctorate in educational leadership at Texas A&M University.
