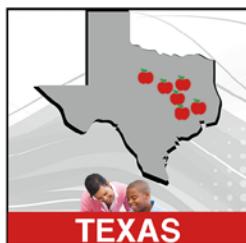

Teachers Advocating to lead Great change is an initiative that builds upon the teacher advocacy component of the Delta Teacher Efficacy Campaign (DTEC). Selected participants are coached in the areas of advocacy and the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) as they create and execute a local TAG Advocacy Project. This program is funded by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

TAG PARTNERSHIPS

TAG Teams partner with local and national organizations in their communities such as chapters of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, schools and universities to enhance the efforts of increased knowledge of ESSA.

TAG STORY

TAG launched as a pilot program in December of 2017. 35 DTEC trained educators were selected from six states to undergo training for education advocacy, analyzing education policy and coalition building to increase community awareness around the Every Student Succeeds Act

Delta Teacher Efficacy Campaign STORY

DTEC is a program that offers professional learning and development to shift mindsets, and perspectives, while providing effective strategies to enhance classroom management, student engagement and instructional strategies.

TAG METHODS

As part of building awareness and knowledge of ESSA, TAG Participants received intense training from TAG Partners the Education Trust and Leadership Conference on education policy analysis, community outreach strategies and advocacy by way of three policy institutions and four webinar trainings.

THE IMPACT

Between April 2014 and March 2019, DTEC-TAG trained and/or engaged over 12,500 educators in 42 states with TAG targeted engagement in DC-MD-VA, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, Tennessee, and Texas.
