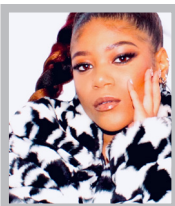

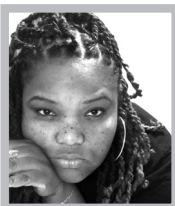
YB TAYLOR, POET
